The Bishop of our Diocese, **The Rt. Rev. Michael Hunn** will visit St. Mark's to have a discussion with the LGBTQ+ Ministry, community, and allies this Sunday, Dec.15th at 6:00 pm.

At a Diocesan event last month, the Bishop shared with me that he fears the LGBTQ+ community will be adversely affected by the new national administration. He suggested that the LGBTQ+ Ministry of the diocese organize a discussion before the inauguration. Bishop Hunn wants to engage in conversation with members of the LGBTQ+ community and their allies about concerns and fears with the new administration, what ideas for action they have for the future, and how our bishop, our diocese, and the church can help facilitate the path forward.

It is wonderful that our Bishop is interested in the well-being of the people of this diocese – especially a group that may soon become more vulnerable. As Christians, we are called to love and watch out for one another. Let us all follow the example of Bishop Hunn and motivate ourselves and others to action. Do not curse the darkness. Light a candle. All are welcome to attend this discussion, either in person or on **ZOOM**.


What an incredible gift! Come join us this Sunday as we distribute these beautiful hats and scarves at Church Unbound!




